The museum houses a world-renowned collection of dolls, dollhouses, and toys; a costume & textile collection; historic photographs; and a Train Gallery with nine working model train layouts. The c. 1690 Claflin-Richards House features three centuries of furnishings, artifacts, and architecture.
