


# Origami Dove Folding Instructions:

1. Start with a square piece of paper.
2. Fold paper diagonally in half.
3. Fold diagonally in half again.
4. With folded edge away from you, fold the top flap up, meeting at the corners
5. Fold the inner corner of the triangle you just created to the middle of the straight edge, making a strong crease.
6. Fold that same crease to the inside (this will make it easier to invert the fold).
7. Unfold the creases where you were just working and reverse the fold, then press down to make a strong crease.
8. Flip the whole thing over and do the same thing on the other side: fold the triangle up to the corner.
9. Fold the inner point to the straight edge.
10. Fold the new crease inside to make it easier to invert the fold.
11. Open the creases and then invert the fold.
12. On the end of the paper with the folded point (the open end will be the bird's wings) turn the paper so the longer side is away from you, then fold the tip down, making a strong crease to start making the beak
13. Then, fold it in the other direction to make it easier to invert this fold, also making a strong crease.
14. Then invert the fold you just made down to make the beak.
15. With the beak end away from you, fold the top wing up.
16. Flip it over and fold the other wing up.
17. With the wings away from you, fold the tail down so that the edge of the tail meets the crease edge that forms the body.
18. Flip it over and fold it down along the same crease.
19. Then open that crease and fold each edge of it around the body.
20. Drop off dove at the museum's reception desk, or in the mailbox (mailbox is located on the corner of the main museum building nearest the parking lot, next to the lilac bush).



Your finished dove will look like this.
